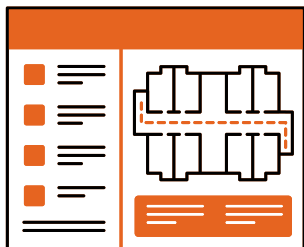


# General Safety Requirements



## General Safety Requirements

- The adult family home must be clean, dry, pest free, and use adequate lighting.
- Provide safe drinking water, bathrooms, and washing facilities.
- Eating areas must be safe and healthy.
- Prohibit tobacco smoke in the adult family home.
- Buildings, floors, stairs, and other structures in the adult family home must be safe, well-built, and free from unsafe holes or openings in the floor.
- Keep all toxic substances and hazardous materials in locked storage and in their original containers.
- Keep all firearms locked and accessible only to authorized people.

## Emergency Evacuation Floor Plan

- The adult family home must display an emergency evacuation floor plan on each floor of the home, and the plan must:
  - Be posted in a visible location commonly used by residents, staff, and visitors alike; and
  - Illustrate the evacuation route from the rooms on that floor to the designated safe location outside the home.



## Fire Extinguishers

The adult family home must have an *approved five-pound 2A:10B-C rated fire extinguisher* on each floor of the home. The fire extinguisher must be mounted or securely fastened in a stationary position, inspected and serviced annually, in proper working order, accessible at all times and not located behind a locked door.
